- Identify the effects of chronic disease or co-morbidity on the presentation and management of acute illness;
- Know when to deliver a fluid challenge safely;
- Describe the conduct of and be aware of the indications and contraindications of the certain practical procedures (Aspiration of Pleural Fluid or Air; Lumbar Puncture and Insertion of central venous pressure line).
