Scenario 1

How do you deal with this information at the ARCP panel?

- ST3 trainee receives outcome 1 following assessment at ARCP panel.
- Enhanced Form R has no declarations by trainee.
- Information from Employer identifies issues with probity.

Can the trainee still progress to their next level of training?



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Scenario 2

How do you deal with this information at the ARCP panel?

- ST4 trainee receives outcome 3 following assessment at ARCP panel.
- No Enhanced Form R submitted by trainee.
- No information received from the Employer.

Can you comment on the trainee's fitness to practise?

Does the outcome 3 have any bearing on their fitness to practise?



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Scenario 3

How do you deal with this information at the ARCP panel?

- ST3 trainee receives outcome 2 at following assessment at ARCP panel.
- Enhanced Form R shows a declaration of an unresolved significant event and an unresolved complaint.
- No information received from the Employer.

How do you comment on this trainee's fitness to practice?



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Scenario 4

How do you deal with this information at the ARCP panel?

- ST4 trainee receives outcome 3 following assessment at ARCP panel.
- Enhanced Form R has no declarations by trainee.
- Information from Employer identifies issues with significant events.
- Panel's decision is to comment that there are concerns regarding fitness to practice.
- When trainee meets with the panel to receive his outcome he denies the concerns raised by the Employer.
