Introduction

The East Midlands Careers Champions scheme puts individuals wishing to develop their career in contact with more senior trainees across specialties. Champions can provide unique and valuable insights into working life in their specialty. This quick user guide will give you an overview of how to use the Careers Champions List.

Accessing the Careers Champions List

Access to our Careers Champions list is restricted to trainees working in the East Midlands and is hosted on our Virtual Learning Environment (VLE). To view the Careers Champions list, you need to visit our VLE course “The Essential Guide to Applications and Interviews” at <http://www.vle.eastmidlandsdeanery.nhs.uk/course/view.php?id=1032>. You will be required to log-in if you’re not already logged in.

Once logged in go to the “My Spaces” section of the Home Menu in the Navigation section on the right-hand side of the screen, then click the “**The Essential Guide to Applications and Interviews**” course name in your “My Spaces” list.

Filtering by Specialty

To find Careers Champions in a particular specialty use the Drop Down list and select one of the specialties. We will have at least one Careers Champion for each of the specialties in the drop down list.

Select a specialty!

We have at least 1 Careers Champion for each specialty appearing in the drop-down list.

As soon as you select a Specialty, the Champions List will be filtered down to Champions from that Specialty. To change the specialty just select a different one from the list, or click the **Clear Specialty Filter** button to remove the specialty search.

If the specialty you are looking for doesn't appear in the drop-down list, we don't – at the current time – have a Careers Champion from that particular specialty. In this case, you can select related specialties from the list, come back to the site at a later date and see if any have been added, or search for the specialty using the [free text search](#) – this may pick up other Careers Champions who have worked or trained in that specialty. We are trying to get as broad a range of specialties covered as possible so if you can't find the specialty you are looking for please [let us know](#) and we can make further effort to identify Champions from that specialty.

Filtering by Out of Programme Experience, Less Than Full Time Training, Career Break or Work Abroad

We have filters that allow you to search for Careers Champions with Out of Programme Experience (OOP), those who have taken a Career Break, are on Less Than Full Time Training (LTFT) or have Worked Abroad. Just click on the appropriate filter button and the list will automatically update to match your criteria. Click the buttons again to remove the filter, or click the **Clear Filter** button.

Click the filter buttons to display Champions who have had an out of programme experience, taken a career break, work less than full time or have worked abroad.

You can use multiple filters at the same time, so pressing the Career Break and LTFT buttons would show you Champions who have had a Career Break and train Less Than Full Time. You can also use the filter buttons after selecting a specialty if you wish to narrow it down just to Champions from a particular Specialty.

You can choose multiple filters if you wish. In this example we have 5 Champions who have taken a career break and train on a less than full time basis.

Free Text Search

The Search box allows you to search for any keywords and automatically filters the list as you type into the box. Searching can be a good way of identifying Careers Champions based in a particular Trust or Hospital, or search for other career-related terms.

If you are using the Careers Champions list on an old browser such as Internet Explorer 8 the dynamic live search won't work, instead we suggest you press **CTRL & F** on the keyboard and use the browser's Find function to search through the Careers Champions instead.

Each Careers Champion has volunteered to be part of the Careers Champion scheme and is waiting and happy to hear from you! We recommend you contact them by email in the first instance (their email address is on the list), although once you have made initial contact, you may follow up with telephone calls, skype or facetime or meet up for a chat – whatever works for you and your Careers Champion!
