<p>The post is ward based on a general medical ward with sub-specialty interest in diabetes and endocrinology. There are 35 beds with a team consisting of 3 consultants, 2 SpRs, 1 CMT trainee, 1 Trust Grade SHO, 2 FY2 and 2 FY1 doctors. The week days begin with a task orientated board round focussing on the patients need, both medical and relating to discharge. The timetable below highlights the general overview of the week and timing of ward rounds, word work and teaching sessions. In addition, there is opportunity to attend out patient clinics in both diabetes and endocrinology to help gain experience in chronic disease management. You will be part of the general medical on call rota, with experience of acute admissions as well as out of hours ward cover during the whole week including nights.</p>
