General Adult Psychiatry, Lincolnshire Partnership Foundation NHS Trust, Pilgrim Hospital Boston
 The FT1 post is based in Boston at the mixed acute in-patient ward (Ward 12)

This post provides 5 days per week experience in acute general adult in-patient psychiatry, working on a busy 20 bedded mixed general adult acute in-patient ward. The ward has an average length of stay between 20 and 40 days. The medical team comprises of a full time Consultant Psychiatrist and one GPVTS. There is a Speciality doctor cover for attached crisis team. This speciality doctor is also available for advice for Ward 12 when needed. The crisis team is next door to acute ward and is supervised by Caroline Brant. This also provides opportunity to shadow crisis team in the community. The ward prides itself on its multi-disciplinary team approach to patient care and, in addition to the above medical staff; we have a full contingent of junior and senior nursing staff and occupational therapy.

The role of the FT1 will be to do physical examinations and be a part of the MDT team in assessing and managing the patients. The FT1 trainees will have opportunity to review patients individually and to present them at ward round discussions. They will also have opportunity to liaise with acute hospital medical team which is next door to department of psychiatry.
