**Main duties:**  
 CRHTTs have been introduced throughout England as part of a transformation of the community mental healthcare system. They aim to assess all patients being considered for acute hospital admission, to offer intensive home treatment rather than hospital admission if feasible, and to facilitate early discharge from hospital. Key features include 24-hour availability and intensive contact in the community, with visits twice daily if needed. Welcome to CRHTT. I am sure you have been flooded by lots of information regarding the trust already. But this is one of the most important information you need to know for the next four months in CRHTT along with 'Junior Doctor's Guide to Psychiatry'.

**Educational Activities:**  
 These are the different types of visits you will do in the community and occasionally in a hospital. Be prepared to do a lot of driving in this job as you will spend most of your day doing home visits.

1. Initial Assessment
2. Medical Review
3. Home Visit
4. Ward Round – You may be asked to attend the ward round for Service-Users who can be potentially discharged from the hospital to the community under the care of CRHTT. You cannot accept or decline a referral without discussing with your seniors.
5. Mental Health Act Assessment – You will accompany a Psychiatrist for this assessment. It will be helpful if you have a quick look at Section 2, 3 and 4 of MHA before you go for this assessment. You are not allowed to do this assessment.

If you have any queries, you can approach the clinical tutor Dr.Chadalavada who will be your educational supervisor if you start the rotation at Berrywood hospital.
