Threre is a weekly tutorial and the foundation doctor is expected to attend the GP speciality training afternoon on a Wednesday and the foundation teaching sessions on Thursday lunchtime. The remainder of Thursday is used for self directed learning. There are other educational activities eg MDT and a protected learning afternoon (monthly) scheduled which the foundation doctor can attend. Other Comments (if appropriate): The practice has a strong educational and multiprofessional approach to delivering primary care. The team includes GPs, an advanced nurse practioner, practice nurses and healthcare workers. There can be several GP registrars and student nurses in post at the same time. There is the usual attachment of community nurses and other allied healthcare professionals. The foundation supervisor is a senior NHS GP appraiser and an examiner for the RCGP.
