<b>Main duties:</b>					
<p>This job allows Foundation Trainees to demonstrate competencies in taking histories of both acute and enduring disorders (e.g. adjustment, affective, psychotic, personality and substance misuse disorders). The trainee will be involved in the assessment of patients admitted following self-harm, and its management. They will assess new admissions both in terms of mental state but also appreciating the higher rates of physical illness in our patient group. They will be delivering day to day care to patients admitted to psychiatric ward and working with CRHT. Trainee will be also assessing patient in outpatient's clinic, new and follow up cases.</p> <p>There will be access to supervision from a senior colleague following all new assessments (which may be via telephone where this is urgent). All assessments will be documented and the trainee will provide written communication as appropriate.</p> <p>They will also participate in ECT clinics and on call rota with appropriate supervision.</p>
