Main duties:

The post gives opportunity for exposure to management of general medicine and acute medicine in older people. 29 beds are shared between 2 consultants, 2 SpRs, 2 SHOs and another FY1 and this post. The ward is a female only ward and has a specialist interest in psychogeriatrics and continence. There are plenty of opportunities for clinical teaching on ward rounds and during the placement.

For those who are interested there will be the opportunity to undertake Geriatric medicine related audits. There is also the opportunity to teach undergraduates. Opportunity to work on the acute assessment and acute frailty units plus night shifts covering the ward.
