## Main duties:

"This post is based in the General Surgical department, which is led by 6 Consultant General Surgeons and includes a 24 bedded acute inpatient unit and a further 2 wards. You will be working as part of a wider team of doctors looking after elective and emergency admissions, with patients coming from across Northamptonshire and Leicestershire. We work as part of a multidisciplinary team which includes Foundation trainees, Core trainees, Specialty trainees, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, pharmacists and a wide range of nursing specialists including cancer, stoma and emergency care practitioners.

Oncall commitments include 12 hour shifts assessing A&E referrals for both urology and general surgical teams. Oncalls are supported by a F1 and registrar on all shifts.

F2s are encouraged to participate fully in all surgical opportunities, including theatre lists and clinics.

There are ample teaching and training opportunities, including participation in quality improvement and audit projects.

The clinical supervisor for this post is Mr Taylor. We are keen to encourage all trainees to make the most of their time working in this busy but supportive department."
