<p>Thus, the Clinical Oncology department rotation in conjunction with combined Oncology/Haematology on calls (09:00 to 21:00) will provide a wide spectrum of clinical exposure allowing for the post holder to fulfil the competencies for completion of foundation training as per the Foundation Curriculum. Indeed the current post holders have faced no difficulties in achieving this goal.</p> <p>The nature of patients seen within The Osbourne Building dictates that their management is undertaken in holistic MDT environment and this enhances opportunities for Generic training in:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Communication (with patients, families, immediate MDT members) 2. Audit: the department has an active clinical governance and quality improvement programme which the trainee will be encouraged to participate in. 3. Ethics: with a diverse range of conditions in a diverse range of patients (age/co-morbidities etc) raises natural questions around the ethics of treatment vs palliative approaches and these are ethical issues which are 'routine' within the department and this exposure proves to be invaluable to current trainees. 4. Teaching: the post holder will have the opportunity to participate in the teaching & training of Medical Students who rotate through the department in year 4 of the Undergraduate course 5. Research: This Tertiary referral centre hosts Professors & Senior Lecturers with strong Academic & University portfolios and, for those wishing to take advantage of this, there are opportunities for abstracts, posters and papers on a wide range of Oncology & Haematology topics.
