<p>This will be a 4 month post based in Anaesthetics and intensive care unit. Generally you will be encouraged to spend 2 months in theatres and 2 months on the ITU. You will work alongside a team consisting of consultant, SpR core trainees and FY2 with your role being supernumery. You will be able to practice a full range of practical skills from bag/mask ventilation to intubation so there will be ample opportunity to gain experience in your core competencies. As well as reviewing patients on the unit, you will have exposure to reviewing sick patients around the hospital accompanying the on call team. You will be able to shadow the oncall reg and attend cardiac arrest and other emergency calls.</p> <p>The clinical supervisor for this post is Dr R Kulkarni who is the faculty tutor for Intensive care.</p>
