This post will be based in the Obstetrics and Gynaecology department at Pilgrim Hospital in Boston. The department has 7 Consultants, 1 Associate Specialist, 7 Specialty Trainees (ST), 3 Specialty doctors, 4 GPST's and 2 Foundation trainees. There are also many Midwifery and Nursing staff that are also invaluable in ensuring safe patient care. The services are provided on the Labour Ward, the clinic area, Maternity ward for Ante- and Post-natal patients as well as the gynaecological ward. Gynaecology theatre is located in the Ground Floor Theatre suite and patients are admitted via the day case unit on the 2nd floor of the main hospital.

The foundation trainee will be exposed to all the resources to enable satisfactory completion of the requirements of the Foundation Curriculum. They will be supervised and supported at all times by all the members of the Medical, Midwifery and Nursing staff. The placement offers direct supervision of clinical practice and workplace based assessmentsas well as permit the trainee to meet their Intended Learning Objectives. All the Consultants are Educational and Clinical supervisors with allotted times throughout the working week for supervision meetings. The trainee will be expected to clerk and present patients in the clinics and on admission, attend Theatres as rostered including pre- and post-op rounds as well as labour Ward duties and emergencies including A&E when required. At all times they will be under the immediate supervision of a Middle-grade or Consultant. They will be responsible for some of the admistrative work including completion of EDDs' etc. The department provides a comprehensive range of services in the speciality appropriate for a district general hospital. The Foundation trainees will join the GPSTs' and ST1 to provide a 1 in 8 on call duties with prospective cover.

Full participation at monthly Clinical governance meetings. Directly supervised clinically at all times by senior doctors. Easy access to computers to aid learning. Opportunity to attend other specialities for taster sessions / days will be facilitated.

## Other Comments (if appropriate):

It is expected that the trainee will become competent at taking an Obstetrics and Gynaecology history and undertaking an examination including a pelvic exam. It is also expected that the skills to initiate the appropriate investigations and communicating with the General Practitioner will be developed.
