Main duties:					
<p>This post is based in the Public Health Division within Nottinghamshire County Council. The Division currently has a Director of Public Health, four Consultants and a multi-disciplinary public health team. In addition Public Health Specialty Registrars and GP and Paediatric HEE Fellows may be on placement within the division. The foundation trainee will be able to satisfy elements of the Foundation Curriculum and will be supervised by a Public Health Consultant working as the Clinical Supervisor, meeting at least monthly but often with daily contact. The placement offers the opportunity to complete a range of projects, including service reviews, literature reviews and evidence-base assessments, linked to individual funding requests and needs assessments, audits and quality improvement activities, evaluation of health promotion and illness prevention initiative campaigns. Developing more advanced skills in data analysis, interpretation and presentation will be developed through work on a range of different projects, together with leadership skills (chairing meetings, leading discussions, presenting work, running the Journal Club) to public health and other audiences.</p> <p>There will be opportunities to attend Clinical Commissioning Group meetings to gain understanding of commissioning in action and how clinicians influence this, attend the Child Death Overview Panel and the Nottinghamshire Health and Wellbeing Board, which oversees the health and social care system.</p> <p>The placement also involves shadowing and attending sessions with public health commissioned services such as smoking cessation, integrated sexual health services, public health nurses and weight management providers. Generic public health work will cover health improvement, health protection and health care public health, focusing on action to address inequalities, equality and quality of services, Project work will be based on interests of F2 wherever possible.</p>
