## **General areas**

The foundation trainee will learn generic skills in history taking, abdominal and vascular examination, and obtaining a collateral history. They will also have plenty of opportunity to develop hand-held Doppler technique and perform ABPIs. They will be involved in organising appropriate investigations, and referring on to other specialists. They will learn how to manage difficult consultations and communication skills, as well as managing patients with multiple significant co-morbidities and learn the basics of the consent process.

The trainee will be under the clinical supervision of a vascular consultant and can expect to meet their supervisor at the beginning, middle and end of their placement, with scope for further meetings if necessary.
