Main duties

The post is based on the Acute Stroke Unit, a 23 bedded unit which includes a 4 bedded, monitored Hypercute Bay to receive stroke patients, 19 acute beds (which includes initial rehabilitation), a rehabilitation gym and therapy assessment area, and patient day room. The F1 doctor has reponsibilty for care of patients on the stroke unit (53) under the supervision of consultant, middle grade and core trainee medical staff. This involves taking part in consultant ward rounds and stroke MDT meetings, reviewing patients, mainting clear medical notes, and effective liaison with other medical staff, nursing colleagues, other members of the multi-disciplinary team and clerical staff. This can involve clerking of acute stroke patients on the ward. Opportunities exist to be involved in the assessment and treatment of stroke patients who may be eligible for thrombolysis treatment. A High Risk TIA clinic is run on the ward and the F1 may have the opportunity to see patients in this clinic under the guidance of senior colleagues. Specific skills which can be developed during this attachment include: improving clinical neurological skills of history taking and examination; increased awareness of the ethical principles involved in caing for patients who may have decreased mental capacity; supplementary feeding including the placement of naso-gastric feeding tubes; multidisciplinary working. Rational use of and interpreation of stroke imaging (CT & MRI brain, carotid doppler)
