Main duties:					
<p>The Foundation 1 doctors are intergral to the ward teams and spend alternate weeks on the general paediatric ward and neonatal unit. The day starts with handover at 8.45 . Ward rounds with consultnat will then commence and the F1 either accompanies the consultnat or sees ward attenders who need reviews, investiagtions etc. The F1 will quickly become competent in phlebotomy in chidlren and are always supported with experienced nursing and play staff. after the ward round the F1 will work under the supervison of the registrar to complete clinical and administrativ tasks identied and ensure that children identified for discharge are sorted out. The ward has a very high teurnover so the F1 will also contribute to admitting new papptietns to the ward. The routine is similar on the neonatal unit where the infants are seen each day and clinicla plans made with a late morning ward round. The F1 may accompany the more senior docotrs to deliveries but are not expected to respond to emergencies independently. There is a hnad over at 4.45. F1 work a long shift on alternate days Monday to Thursday but not Fridays and have a short afternoon on a Friday. A long day ends at 8.30 pm. They also do short days at the weekend 1:4 but no nights. The posts are very well supported with a full team of SHO and registrars.</p>
