The post-holder will also gain experience in the minor specialties including Ophthalmology, ENT and Maxillofacial surgery. They will also perform such procedures as suturing, manipulation of simple fractures and dislocations etc. The post-holder also participates in the hospital's on-call rota, providing ward cover for the medical and surgical wards out of hours.</p>
