Exposure to primary breast reconstructive techniques. There is also exposure to Colorectal and Urology cases. There is ample opportunity to undertake audit project. Emergency surgery exposure is via 2 four-day blocks at Lincoln County Hospital SEAU. There are weekly X-ray MDT meetings and monthly surgical audit/M&amp;M meetings. Out of hours, the trainee will also form part of the Grantham-based on-call team, which provides experience in general medicine as well as surgery.</p>
