<p>This post offers training and experience in general medicine with an emphasis on cardiology. Main duties include managing acute medical admissions and planning the longer-term care of chronic conditions. Undertaking ward rounds with senior staff, organizing investigations and treatment, reviewing response to treatment and managing patients on daily ward rounds. Simple procedures, looking for and addressing complications of medical conditions, assessing National Early Warning Scores (NEWS) and dealing with the sick patient, safety issues and audit opportunities, prioritizing work in a busy environment, being on-call and dealing with/presenting new admissions to the consultants and dealing with inpatient emergencies on call.</p>

Bedside teaching is provided by senior staff during ward rounds, and there are regular one-to-one tutorials in cardiology.</p>
