Job Description

General Adult Psychiatry, Lincolnshire Partnership Foundation NHS Trust Grantham

The FT1 post is based in Grantham at the community mental health team and the Inpatient general adult psychiatric rehabilitation ward – Ashley house.

Inpatient Placement (Ashley House, Beaconfield, Grantham)

This post provides experience in acute general adult in-patient psychiatry, working on a 16 bedded unit for patient with Chronic and enduring mental illnesses (age18-65).

The ward prides itself on its multi-disciplinary team approach to patient care and, in addition to the medical staff; we have a full contingent of junior and senior nursing staff, occupational therapy, and access to specialist psychology, physiotherapy and day hospital resources.

The role of the FT1 will be to do physical examinations and be a part of the MDT team in assessing and managing the patients

The FT1 trainee will have opportunity to review patients individually and to present them at ward round discussions . They will take part in Family meetings, CPA ,and other MDT meetings. This will be supervised by Dr Corrine Lewis.

Community clinical work

The trainee will also undertake clinical work in a community setting under the close supervision of Dr Worwood – the clinical supervisor. The community team provides input in managing mental illness in adults between between age 18 and 65, covering the catchment General Practices in Grantham and Sleaford.

The trainee will primary be involved in the assessment, diagnosis and management of severe and mental health illnesses in the adult population. Clients with psychotic illnesses, depression, anxiety, personality disorder and substance misuse form core of referrals to the secondary care team. The trainee will also provide input to the Home Treatment team which supports clients needing intensive input for short periods of time. In addition, the trainee may carry out crisis assessments in the community and liaise with allied professionals.

The Trainee will complete all work under close supervision of Dr Worwood or his higher Trainee (ST).
