Ward 12 is shared with another general adult consultant.

The inpatient acute and Open Rehabilitation psychiatric ward pride themselves on their multi-disciplinary team approach to patient care. The medical team consist in ward 12 of a Full time consultant psychiatrist, GPVTS trainee, Foundation year two and a specialist doctor, and an extra specialist doctor for maple Lodge. In addition, we have a full contingent of junior and senior nursing staff and occupational therapy. The role of the FT1 will be to do physical examinations and be a part of the MDT team in assessing and managing the patients. The FT1 trainees will have opportunity to review patients individually and to present them at ward round discussions. They will also have opportunity to liaise with acute hospital medical team which is next door to department of psychiatry.
