Main duties:

Elective general surgery – ward based care of elective general and endocrine patients, theatre lists and outpatient clinics Elective breast surgery – operating theatre sessions.

Emergency general surgery –assessment and management of undifferentiated general surgical emergency admissions including trauma and emergency theatres.

Surgical Hospital at Night – ward based out of hours problems occurring in surgical patients on City Hospital Campus. The surgical hospital at night team covers general and breast surgery, urology, elective orthopaedics, cardiac and thoracic surgery and plastics/burns.

During each four week period of the placement (excluding leave) the FY2 can expect to do approximately:

- · 2 weeks elective general, endocrine and breast surgery
- 1 week of day time emergency surgery Monday-Thursday
- 1 weeks of an out of hour shift with the surgical hospital at night team

Educational Activities:

The placement offers broad experience in elective and emergency general surgery including endocrine and breast surgery.
