<p>F21 has 28 beds which are occupied by patients with acute hepatology and luminal gastroenterology problems. F22 has 9 clinical nutrition unit beds occupied by patients with complex nutritional problems and 9 isolation beds for patients with C Diff or other infective diarrhoea. Trainees will be allocated to one of these ward areas and will be responsible for the day to day management and investigation of these patients. They will also have the opportunity to attend the endoscopy unit to learn about this aspect of their patient's care. Additionally they will have duties on the medical daycase unit where they will contribute to the care of patients undergoing therapeutic paracentesis, liver biopsy, and other minor procedures</p>
