**Main duties:**

This post is based on the dedicated head & neck ward at the Royal Derby Hospital. There are five full time consultant Maxillofacial surgeons, three specialist registrars, a head & neck fellow and eight Dental Core Trainees.

The role includes managing the patients admitted under the care of the maxillofacial team. The foundation trainee will be able to satisfy requirements of the Foundation Curriculum and will be supported by the trainees and consultant working on the unit.

The placement offers direct supervision of clinical practice and workplace based assessments, alongside a clearly delineated role to permit the trainee to meet their Intended Learning Objectives for the foundation programme.

In addition to the ward base work, the trainee has the opportunity to attend theatres, and specialist out patient clinics. They will also, under appropriate supervision, attend to and treat facial trauma patients presenting to ED. The trainee will be encouraged to assist in audit projects. They will attend the foundation teaching programme as well as the weekly departmental teaching sessions. There is no call commitment for this post. The clinical supervisor for this post is Mr David Laugharne, Consultant Maxillofacial / Head & Neck Surgeon.

**Other Comments (if appropriate):**

The foundation trainee will be part of a busy maxillofacial team. Their main role is the management of the maxillofacial patients on the head & neck ward including patients who have undergone major head & neck cancer resection and reconstruction, facial deformity surgery and temporomandibular joint replacement. There are also patients presenting through ED with facial trauma and cervical facial infections. The trainee will be expected to develop interdisciplinary team working with both the medically and dentally qualified trainees.
