<p>You will be in theatre from day one, working alongside an experienced senior anaesthetist. You will learn basic and advanced airway management, the conduct of anaesthesia, pain management, resuscitation and fluid management. You should get the opportunity to insert lines for invasive monitoring and see regional anaesthesia. You will be taught the principles of pre operative assessments of both the emergency and elective patient and the assessment of patients for critical care. By the end of your placement, you should be adept at resuscitation of sick patients and recognise when and how to escalate their care.</p>
