<p>This post in Anaesthetics is based principally in Theatres, learning important anaesthetic skills such as General & Regional anaesthesia, basic & advanced airway management, venous cannulation, record-keeping, pain management including nerve blocks and sedation and pharmacology of anaesthetic agents. The postholder will also participate in pre-assessment clinics, Critical Care Outreach rounds and spend time on the High Dependency Unit; there will be direct supervision by a consultant, SAS doctor or Senior Sister at all times. In HDU you will learn assessment & management of critically ill patients. In addition you will observe decision making regarding end of life care and breaking bad news. The post also includes opportunities to attend chronic pain clinics and acupuncture sessions, and participate in audit/QI projects.</p>
